Katy Plotner, 4th grade teacher at Leal Elementary School in Urbana is incorporating technology skills in her classroom this school year by having her students create their own digital portfolios. Throughout the year her students will scan their work into a computer, create digital recordings of the work and write about what they learn. To do this requires a classroom scanner and portable flash drives for storing student data. With her CUSF Splash Grant, Katy is purchasing the scanner and 30 flash drives so each of her students will have their own to use! The portable flash drives will let students share their work with their families strengthening the connection between home and school. Katy knows that when her students reflect on what they have studied they will have a deeper understanding of what they have learned.
