Lisa Roundtree teaches first grade at Champaign's South Side Elementary School. She has been teaching for eight years and knows how important it is for students to have access to literacy support, especially in the first grade. With her Splash Grant money, Lisa was able to purchase hands-on materials that help students learn letter identification, associate letters with the sounds that they make and recognize high-frequency words. These materials are available to her first-grade students at classroom centers during their Reading Workshop time. The students have the choice to work alone or with friends and in a structured or exploratory manner. Her goal is to have all first-grade students working at or above the district's benchmark reading level by the end of the school year. Congratulations, Lisa!
