Funds will be used to purchase materials for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> graders to promote financial literacy and math through learning about money. Students will have hands on experiences in the classroom and at home. Each student will have access to money manipulatives, games, and saving tools.

***Dreams & Possibilities*** submitted by Amanda Moore from Garden Hills in Champaign. Funds will be used to create incentives for special education students to build social skills by earning opportunities for desired activities.

***Cost Benefit for Growing our own food*** submitted by Julie Norcross from Kenwood in Champaign. Second grade students will have hands on experience in growing their own food from seeds both at school and at home, while learning about cost benefit analysis.
